Monster Hunter Wilds to Launch on Nintendo Switch 2 on December 4, 2026!

- Three *Resident Evil* Remake titles also coming to
Nintendo Switch 2 as part of Capcom's multi-platform strategy -

Capcom Co., Ltd. (Capcom) today announced the release dates of *Monster Hunter Wilds*, *Resident Evil 2 Deluxe Edition*, *Resident Evil 3*, and *Resident Evil 4 Gold Edition* for Nintendo Switch™ 2.

Monster Hunter Wilds is the latest title in the same hunting action game series, released in February 2025. It is the first title in the series to feature cross-play, providing players with an environment in which they can enjoy the game together regardless of platform. To further expand its user base, Capcom has now announced that it will also release the game on Nintendo Switch 2 on December 4, 2026. Further, *Monster Hunter Wilds: Ascendance*, a massive expansion for the title, will also have a Nintendo Switch 2 version and is scheduled for release in 2027.

In addition, Capcom will release three titles from the company's flagship *Resident Evil* series on the Nintendo Switch 2 on October 16, 2026: *Resident Evil 2 Deluxe Edition*, *Resident Evil 3*, and *Resident Evil 4 Gold Edition*. By releasing major titles such as *Resident Evil 2*—which has achieved more than 20 million units in cumulative sales worldwide—on new platforms, the company aims to further expand its user base.

Capcom remains firmly committed to expanding its user base by releasing major titles across multiple platforms, while maximizing unit sales and enhancing its brand value over medium to long term.
